WHAT IS TRAINING CAMP ?

Training Camp is a kid’s summer camp. This will be the 12th year for the camp. The purpose of the camp is to provide an opportunity for kids from Kentucky, Indiana, Illinois and southern Wisconsin to grow in God’s Word in an outdoor setting.

WHO MAY ATTEND CAMP?

Training Camp is for young people in the WELS and ELS who will be entering grades 3-9 in the fall.

WHAT DO WE DO AT CAMP?

Under the guidance of Christian counselors your child will be involved in: daily devotions and Bible studies, arts and crafts, hiking, boating, tower climbing, swimming, singing, and athletics of all types.

WHAT ARE THE DATES?

Camp will be held for a full week from Sunday, July 25 through Friday, July 30.

HOW MANY CAN ATTEND?

We have room for 80 campers. Registration deadline is June 30. Registrations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis.



THEME FOR 2010

The theme for this year comes from a popular TV game show — *Wipeout*. In our devotions and Bible studies, the campers will discover how God is with them to overcome all obstacles to their faith and life. This year, in addition to crafts and experiments, we will also work as teams to overcome physical challenges and obstacles.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

The total cost for this year is \$215 per camper. This includes lodging, meals, snacks, experiments, lake and canoe time, swimming and climbing tower. Your child will not need any extra money at camp. A **non-refundable** \$50 deposit is due with your registration form. The balance is due when you arrive at camp.

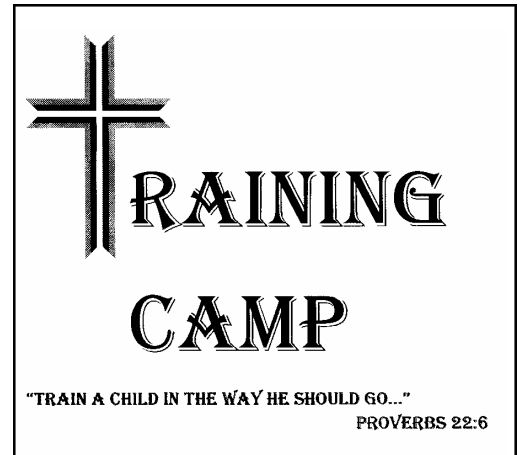
Last year, several campers were able to attend camp because they were sponsored. If you have any questions about this program, please call (262) 637-5182 and ask for Pastor Michael Zarling.
